

## **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and the Use of Scripture**

CGS is rooted in scripture and leads the children into a relationship with Christ through meditation on scripture. Great care is taken to show the sacredness of God's Word. When scripture is read aloud the New American translation is used to help children gain familiarity with the Word of God they will hear proclaimed at Mass. Catechists read directly from a Bible to show the source of the words, light a candle to show how these words are meant to guide us. This is done even with the youngest children. The lit candle also ties the reading of the scripture in the Atrium to the liturgy of the church where we also have lit candles with the reading of scripture. The scripture the youngest children are introduced to comes mostly from the New Testament. The Old Testament passages they hear are limited to messianic prophecies, Psalms. Children reflect on Old Testament passages like The Fall, the Flood, or Moses only after they have been grounded in the person of Christ and the Pascal Mystery, and have the ability to reflect on these passages in the light of Christ's redemption. The amount of scripture children are exposed to goes beyond the scripture the catechist reads, in that as the children grow in skills they are encouraged to look up scripture passages for their own research. Topics children might research on their own include, but are not limited to, biblical geography, prophets, and the miracles of Jesus. Catechists also include Bible studies on passages that are not included in Atrium presentations as a regular event in Level II and III Atria. The topics most often engaged in these Bible studies are indicated by an asterisk on the list below. A double asterisk indicates those that would often be used as part of communal prayer. A list of additional recommended scripture passages for Atrium Bible study and prayer could be developed for catechists using the remaining Archdiocesan Recommended Scripture passages.
